3 Matters Arising/Updates

Action

- 3.1 William Etheridge, the 14-year-old who has been watering the two new trees in the park, has now finished his three month community project for the Duke of Edinburgh Award. Cllr Barber asked for his details to be sent to her so that she could ask the Mayor to sent a certificate of appreciation to him.
- 3.2 Cllr Barber gave an update on the park toilet block. The new proposal for is for a composting one which does not need running water. DC reported that he had experience of one on Spring Road allotments and it wasn't pleasant for women to use as the seat was always wet.

After discussion it was agreed the proposal was unsatisfactory and perhaps both a women's and gents' one would be more acceptable for the park. Consultation with other interested parties especially if anyone has one in situ is ongoing.

Cllr Quinton said that as a Councillor he has a locality fund that he or his colleagues migth be able to help out with.
